Swimmers Code of Conduct

1. Arrive on time for training, and be prepared/ready to swim at the beginning of the session.
2. Show respect for your team-mates, coaches, club officials, pool staff, parents and members of the public.
3. Be well mannered and show a good example of good behaviour to all your team-mates, coaches, club officials, pool staff, parents and members of the public.
4. Have a good and positive attitude.
5. Do not swear or use bad language in public.
6. Listen and respond quickly to your coach.
7. Respect others in the changing rooms.
8. At competitions, remember to wear DARTES team kit. Show respect for other competitors. Listen to instructions from the coaches and team manager.
9. Ensure that any negative remarks or conversations are not spread to other parents and especially swimmers. Any malicious gossip heard should be reported to the appropriate person i.e. coach, team manager or Club Welfare Officer.

Parents Code of Conduct

1. Ensure that swimmers are on poolside in time for training.
2. Ensure that your child is collected on time at the end of the training session. It is not the responsibility of the coach to look after your child prior to or after the session is finished. If this is not possible, please inform the coach.
3. To be respectful to all swimmers, coaches, other parents, club officials and committee members.
4. To encourage swimmers to behave appropriately in training and at galas. If you witness any inappropriate behaviour by other swimmers, coaches or parents, this should be reported to the appropriate person i.e. coach, team manager or club welfare officer.
5. To contact the coach if your swimmer is having any problems. Please wait until after the training session if doing this in person.
6. To support all swimmers during training, galas and championships in an appropriate manner.
7. Ensure that any negative remarks or conversations are not spread to other parents and especially swimmers. Any malicious gossip heard should be reported to the appropriate person i.e. coach, team manager or Club Welfare Officer.
8. Parents are requested to stay on the spectator balconies during training and galas (including morning training sessions) and not enter the poolside unless invited.
9. To pay membership, training and gala entry fees on time.
